Being in the FCHS Band is a tremendously rewarding experience. However, the Band receives only minimal transportation support from Fairfax County for the program. To offset our operational costs, we collect a minimal fee from the Band students (as do the majority of all other FCHS activities) and fundraise like crazy! So that you can better understand what our operational costs are, the Band Aides have broken down how much we spend towards our activities:

FCHS Band Aides spending per student for 1 year = \$800 (does not include the spring trip)

Breakdown:

Transportation and Participation fees (Competitions, solo ensemble etc)	\$175

Our parent group, Band Aides, has taken on a large **fundraising** role each year to help offset the total cost for our children to participate. Last year, the Band Aides raised over \$35,000 which helped cover approximately **60% of the cost of participation** in Marching and Concert Band. Everyone needs to help!

Students can do **individual fundraising** to offset this trip cost by doing activities coordinated by the Band Aides. Examples include: the selling of Holiday "Greens" and Citrus in the fall and other targeted fundraising that adds monies into student accounts. **Several students paid for their ENTIRE Spring Trip (approx. \$500+) by fundraising.** Student fundraising totaled \$3,000 last year.
